We are writing to inform you of our updated punctuality procedures. Ministry of Education guidelines expect students to arrive at school at 7:45am for form class so they can receive important work, vital information, and news for the day.

- 1. At the beginning of the school day a warning bell will sound at 7:45am
- 2. Pupils go to **form** class for registration
- 3. At **7:50am** a second bell will sound to signify the beginning of registration time
- 4. If your child is not in registration at this time they are classified as late
- 5. Pupils can still go to **form class** before 8:00am
- 6. All gates in school will automatically LOCK at 8:00am
- 7. The ONLY access will be through the main gate at the front of the school
- 8. Students arriving after 8.00am will have to obtain a LATE SLIP from the LATE **ROOM** before proceeding to morning Assembly
- 9. Pupil will give the LATE SLIP to their Form Teacher
- 10. Students arriving after 8.20am will have to remain in the LATE ROOM until the start of the next lesson

Please be reminded that students should always bring a note if they are late to school.

If your child arrives to school late:

- Stage 1: First time Verbal warning
- Stage 2: Second time Parent meeting, letter signed and Detention given
- Stage 3: Students will remain in the Late room to be collected by their Parents

Coming to school every day is very important because it ensures the child reaches their full potential and teaches them to value education and learning. Ongoing lateness will affect a student's attendance and may impact on a student's eligibility for promotion the following year. Please make sure your child is on time for school each day.
